

Pool Installation Checklist

If you have any questions, or if anything on this list is unresolved as your date nears, please email or call to let us know!

- Pool delivered and accessible (not locked in a shed or garage).
- Building permit in order.
- Bobcat access – 6-ft wide; If necessary, remove fence/gate.
- “Live” electrical outlet for our tools.
- Working water source with enough hose to easily reach pool.
Note: a leaking hose or spigot will waste water and cause a big mess and possible damage.
- Bags of sand for sand filter (rarely shipped with pool)
- Site marked. Either paint out perimeter of pool wall, pump/filter location, and dirt/grass location or stake out as follows:
Round Pool: 1 center stake **-OR- Oval Pool:** stakes at 4 “corners”
Pump/filter location: 2 stakes
Location for dirt/grass/debris pile: 3 stakes.
- Prepared for payment of balance.

Important notes:

1. If you require precise placement of the pool, that can't vary by even a few inches – for example, a tight spot where any variation would violate town codes – please let us know and be sure we are on the same page before excavation begins.
2. If I need to drive Bobcat into backyard using a specific route (to avoid septic, patio, etc.) please let me know.
3. Keep in mind most times the debris/dirt/grass pile is much better than homeowner expects
